Notice is hereby given pursuant to V.T.C.A., Government Code, Chapter 551, that the Board of Directors (the "Board") of Bilma Public Utility District (the "District") of Harris County, Texas, will meet in regular session, open to the public, at 5:00 p.m., on Thursday, June 6, 2019, at the Spring Creek Oaks Clubhouse II, 6002 Bur Oak, Spring, Texas 77379, at which meeting the following items will be considered:

- A. Hear from public;
- B. **CONSENT AGENDA:** The following items are considered routine by the District and will be enacted by one motion. No separate discussion will occur on these items unless a Board member or member of the public so requests, in which event, the item will be removed from the general order of business and considered in its normal sequence on the agenda.
 - 1. Approval of minutes of the regular meeting of May 2, 2019;
 - 2. Review and approve pay estimates and change orders to construction contracts, as needed;

 - e. status of Storm Water Quality Management Plan for District detention ponds, and take any necessary actions on same;

 11. Discuss North Harris County Regional Water Authority mobile teaching trailer at Spring Creek Oaks Community Improvement Association July 4th event;
 12. Discuss consultant evaluations, and take any necessary actions on same;
 13. Discuss need for solicitation of proposals for renewal of insurance;
 14. Review and approve Post-Issuance Tax-Exempt Debt Compliance Policy checklist; and
 15. Attorney's Report, including legislative update and re-scheduling of July meeting date.
